OUR MISSION

Goodwill Industries of Central Texas (GICT) is a private, 501(C)3 non-profit organization dedicated to the mission of providing job-related services and opportunities for people with barriers to employment.

Celebrating 50 years of service to Central Texas, GICT assists adults and youth with disabilities and disadvantaging conditions obtain competitive employment within the community.



Goodwill believes the power of work enhances the quality and dignity of life for individuals, families and our community. Therefore, our programs are designed to help individuals with barriers find, obtain, and retain jobs in our community.

Job-related services include:

- Application and interview skills
- Resume writing
- Job search assistance
- Job coaching and development
- Information and referral services
- Case management and support services
- Assistive Technology Lab training

The population we serve is:

- People with mental, physical or emotional disabilities
- People with disadvantaging conditions which may include welfare dependency, criminal history or homelessness, history of substance abuse, advanced age, language barriers and lack of education or work experience.

These barriers may prevent individuals from working in competitive employment. By using a variety of job training and employment programs, GICT assists individuals in our community locate, obtain and retain competitive employment.



SERVING OUR COMMUNITY

Goodwill helps thousands of Central Texans find meaningful employment every year.

In 2008:

- 10,125 individuals in Central Texas were assisted
- 32,810 job-related services were provided to these individuals
- 2 people with barriers to employment were placed in competitive employment every day

With community support, Goodwill generates revenue through four major business divisions to fund the mission.

- Retail Services (RS) – Processes and resells donated goods
- Goodwill Staffing Services (GSS) – A full-service staffing company
- Environmental Business Services (EBS) – De-manufactures, recycles and resells donated computers
- Contract Services (CS) – Provides contract services to state, federal and local businesses

ABOUT US

Goodwill Industries of Central Texas (GICT) was created in 1958 to help people with disabilities find gainful employment. Our Workforce Development Services has programs to help youth and adults with barriers to employment gain competitive jobs. Three major areas are:

- Job Source Programs (adults)
- Community Rehabilitation Programs (adults referred by community agencies)
- Youth Services Programs (ages 14-21)

By creating revenue generating business divisions, GICT has been able to support the many programs available to help the community.

Retail Services

- Largest revenue generating department, receives donations of gently used goods which are processed and sold.

Goodwill Staffing Services

- Offers a full service staffing company, providing temporary and temp-to-full time employment solutions for state, federal and local businesses.

Contract Services

- Provides contract services to state, federal and local businesses performing jobs from janitorial, mail room service and reception.

Environmental Business Services

- Addresses the electronic waste concern by refurbishing donated computers and parts at affordable prices to the community as well as de-manufactures and recycles computers that cannot be resold. Currently, in Austin, Goodwill recycles more than 230 tons of electronic waste each month from local landfills.
