The bookstore and donation center will provide Leander residents with a convenient location to drop off gently used goods to be resold in Goodwill retail stores. Funds raised from the sale of donated items will support Goodwill's mission of providing job-related services for people with barriers to employment.

The Leander ADC site is located at 651 N. US HWY 183, Suite 160 at the HEB Plus Center. They will be accepting all donations except furniture items, which must be dropped off at a retail store location.
