Goodwill Opens Attended Donation Center in Taylor

AUSTIN, TX – In an effort to expand and become a part of the Taylor community, Goodwill Industries of Central Texas received permission from HEB to place an Attended Donation Center (ADC) trailer in the HEB Center located at 100 NW Carlos G. Parker Blvd.

The ADC trailer was set up on a trial basis for three months to determine the response of community members. Goodwill supports the Central Texas community through its job services and programs for people with barriers to employment, and seeks to have a greater impact in Taylor and surrounding areas.

At the end of the three month trial, donation amounts will be accessed to determine whether or not the organization can sustain the growth in Taylor. The goal is to open a bookstore and donation center if Goodwill receives enough support from Taylor residents. Ultimately, Goodwill would like to someday open a retail store to serve the community and further the organization's mission.

Goodwill Industries of Central Texas currently serves three of the fifteen counties in its service area, and continuously searches for growth opportunities to assist as many community members as possible through their programs and services.
